### HUSKY VILLAGE APPLICATION

The University of Connecticut is accepting housing applications from social fraternities and sororities registered with the Office of Fraternity and Sorority Life (OFSL). This is for Husky Village D1, a 30-bed facility, for the contract term effective May 16, 2009 through May 13, 2016.

Please respond to each individual item in this document separately referencing the relevant heading (I, II, III, etc.). All information included in an organization's submitted application will be held in confidence by the OFSL and Residential Life for the strict purpose of assessing a Chapter's eligibility for housing.

Completed applications should be sent (in Word or PDF format) via email to [todd.c.sullivan@uconn.edu](mailto:todd.c.sullivan@uconn.edu). Hard copies may also be submitted to the OFSL, Student Union Room 315. Applications will be reviewed upon receipt. The deadline for consideration is **5:00pm on Friday, March 27, 2009**. Applications will be reviewed and organizations will be notified of selection results no later than Wednesday, April 8, 2009.

- I. Contact Information: Include name, position, phone, email, and mailing address for all of the following, as applicable: Chapter President, Housing Chair (undergraduate), Alumni/ae Housing Contact, Alumni/ae Advisor, Campus Faculty/Staff Advisor, and Inter/National Housing Contact.
- II. Purpose, Interest, Community: In 750 words or less, explain the purpose of the organization, why Husky Village housing is sought, and how the Chapter has positively contributed to the Greek and UConn communities.
- III. Accreditation Adherence: In 500 words or less, explain how the organization is complying (or plans to comply) with the Chapter Management section of the Project Arête Accreditation Program (pp. 12-13), available here: <http://www.greeklife.uconn.edu/forms.html>.
- IV. Contract Adherence: In 500 words or less, explain how the organization plans to comply with Section V. (Obligations of the Chapter/Corporation) of the Husky Village Housing Contract (pp. 2-4), available here: <http://www.greeklife.uconn.edu/housing.html>.
- V. Community Housing Application: Has the organization applied for (and been granted) on-campus community housing in the past? If so, does the organization want this information to be reviewed and considered along with this application?
- VI. Roster: Submit a full membership roster with PeopleSoft numbers and class years (freshman through senior). Identify the 30 members selected by the Chapter to live in Husky Village, plus an additional 10 on a waiting list.
- VII. Payment: A deposit check in the amount of \$10,000 must be made payable to "University of Connecticut" and mailed to: University of Connecticut, 233 Glenbrook Rd, Unit 4022, Department of Residential Life, Storrs, CT 06269, Attn: Mary Jo Andreoli. Full deposits (with no interest) will be returned to organizations that a) are not selected for occupancy, or b) withdraw their application via written notice to the University.
